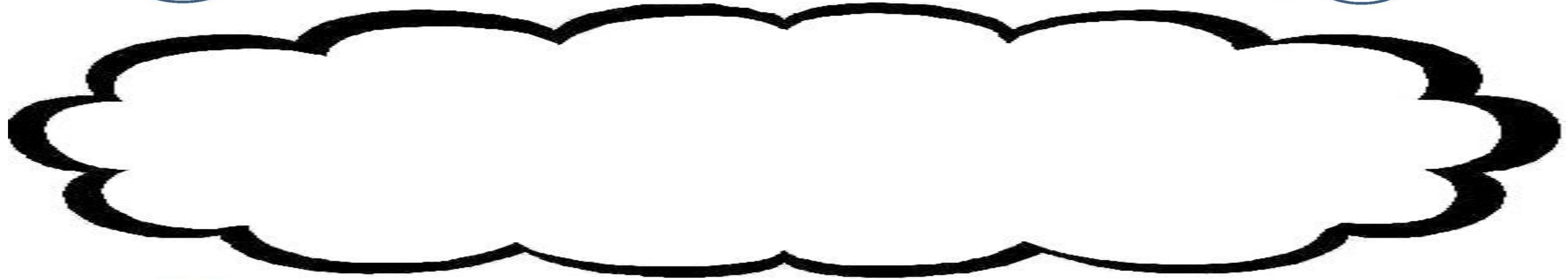

- What evidence or real life examples can be used to support these arguments and claims?
- What are the strengths and weaknesses of the arguments? Are there counter-arguments?
- What are the implications to accepting any of these arguments?

BRAINSTORMING CONCLUSIONS

Remember: Your conclusion should be consistent with the analysis of your KQ and be shown to be applicable to your RLS

- What is your overall answer to the KQ? Is it consistent with your analysis?
- Have you avoided simple black/white thinking?
- How does your evaluation relate back to the RLS?
- How does your conclusion help you to understand other RLSs?
